

2. Approval of budget adjustment for \$500 as Bentonville Public Library applied for, and received, a "mini-grant" for General Improvement Funds (GIF) from the Arkansas State Library. The funds will be used to purchase a digital display monitor and appropriate hardware for the children's department story time space. The new display monitor will eliminate the need to mass reproduce paper handouts that accompany weekly rhymes and songs. Further, it will allow library staff to supplement and support children's services using animation, picture and music to encourage a lifelong love of books and learning in children.
3. Ordinance repealing Section 3 through Section 10 of Ordinance No. 2005-40 amending operating policies and procedures for the Airport Advisory Board.
4. Approve revision to SOG #207- Controlled Medication Standard Operating Guideline for the Fire Department.
5. Approve resolution authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to enter into a contract with Bentonville Medical Associates to perform the annual medical surveillance exams for firefighters.
6. Approve Ordinance authorizing issuance of a 3 year dog license for applicants submitting proof of a 3 year rabies vaccination, and establishing reduced licensing fees during the months of April and October of each year. Arkansas law now allows veterinarians to issue a 3 year rabies vaccination certificate. This amendment will allow our licensing ordinance to accommodate this new regulation. Additionally, in order to encourage citizens to license their dogs, this amendment establishes 2 months per year (April and October) with reduced licensing costs. The Police Department Administrative Services Division, which oversees Animal Control, and the Utility Billing Department, which issues licenses, both support these modifications, and I am submitting this Ordinance at their request.
