

GARAGE SALES

The City of Bentonville no longer requires a permit to hold a garage sale. However, regulations still apply.

- Keep your sale to no more than three (3) days in length
- Only post signs three (3) days prior to sale
- Remove the signs within twenty-four (24) hours after the sale
- The signs must include the address and dates of the sale
- Place the signs behind the sidewalk or 10' (10 feet) from the back of the curb where there is no sidewalk
- Signs must not exceed six (6) feet in area
- Signs are allowed to be placed on the property where the sale is being held and one (1) sign at the nearest major intersection to your street

Neighborhood Garage Sale Signs:

- A neighborhood yard sale sign can advertise for a neighborhood yard sale event when a minimum of three households within the same subdivision have individual yard sales simultaneously.
- Sign can be posted up to 7 days prior to the sale and must be removed one (1) day after the event.
- Signs need to include date(s) of the sale and, at a minimum, the site address of the coordinator of the event.
- The sign can be up to 32 square feet.
- One can be placed per subdivision entry. The must be attached to a permanent subdivision entry sign. If no subdivision entry sign exists, the sign shall be attached to a fence or building near the subdivision entry.
