



Tool Trailer Lending Agreement

The Tool Sharing Trailer comes equipped with a variety of items needed for mowing & yard maintenance, tree & shrub trimming, household & fence repair, and more. The trailer is available at no cost for registered neighborhood partners.

The goal of the Tool Sharing Trailer is to make it easier for residents to maintain their property and become closer with their neighbors. Members can reserve the entire trailer for a neighborhood maintenance workday or reserve a specific tool category depending on the project.

The trailer and/or trailer materials is available for reservations Monday-Friday and may be reserved for up to three days. If the entire trailer is reserved, it cannot be relocated once delivered.

Please place your request for the trailer and tools at least two weeks in advance. The Tool Trailer is checked out on a first come, first served basis. Please fill out [this form](#) indicating supplies, project, contact information, pick up & return dates. Filling out this form means acceptance of terms, conditions, & liabilities.

Rules for trailer and supplies use:

- Supplies may be checked out for up to three days at a time.
- You may check out one item or multiple items.
- A Bentonville Code Enforcement Officer will deliver and pickup the trailer.
- If a tool is damaged outside of normal wear and tear, or it is lost, you may be held responsible for repair or replacement.
- Commercial use is not allowed. This program is designed for Bentonville residents to maintain their personal property.
- You must be 18 years or older to reserve.
